## Ladyfest 2000 FACT SHEET



Women in Olympia have been meeting. Since December 1999, more than 30 women have come together to plan what will be Olympia's largest women's art festival.

What is the mission of Ladyfest?

Ladyfest 2000 is a cultural and educational event designed by and for women. Our mission is to celebrate, showcase and encourage the artistic, organizational and political talents of women.

What types of events will be happening at Ladyfest?

This participatory festival will feature performances by bands, spoken word artists, authors, visual artist and filmmakers. It will include workshops, panel discussions and children's activities. Depending on the topic, some workshops will be women-only. All events are trans-inclusive.

When is Ladyfest?

The event is scheduled for August 1-6, 2000 in various locations throughout downtown Olympia, including The Capitol Theater, Midnight Sun, Arrowspace, and the Olympia Community Center.

Who is organizing Ladyfest?

Ladyfest is a woman-run event, and is operating as a non-profit organization. All event organizers are volunteering their time. There will also be volunteer opportunities at the festival.

What bands/performers/artists are confirmed for Ladyfest?

Confirmed bands include: Sleater-Kinney, Bratmobile, Lois, The Need, The Bangs, Sarah Dougher, and Frenchie & the German Girls. Confirmed visual artists include: photographer Cynthia Connoly (Banned in D.C./Dischord records) and papercut artist Nikki McClure. Confirmed art shows include: Fabric Show, Girls Show (ages toddler – teen), Beauty Tip show, general group show (open to submissions), and installations.

How can men be involved with Ladyfest?

Men are welcome to attend the festival, host a benefit show, donate money or services, volunteer at the actual event.
